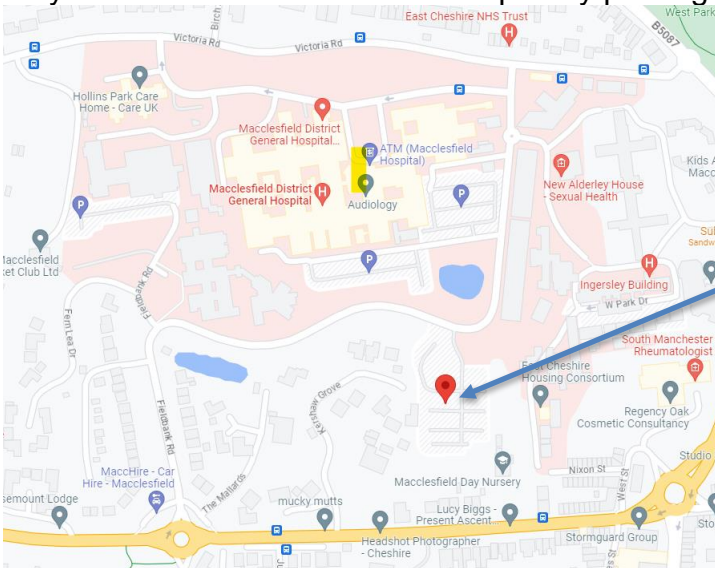


Liftshare at East Cheshire NHS Trust

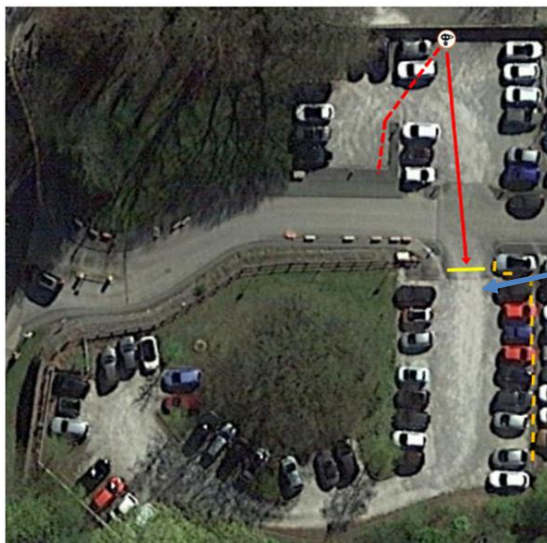
Liftshare offers another way of reducing your fuel costs, allows access to dedicated priority parking on site, reduces your own carbon footprint, and allows for you to change to a car-share permit for further cost savings.

Liftshare priority parking spaces at Macclesfield District General Hospital

To park on site, you will need an existing parking permit. For those staff that then choose to Liftshare they will be able to have access to priority parking spaces located at the Paddock.

a parking charge.**

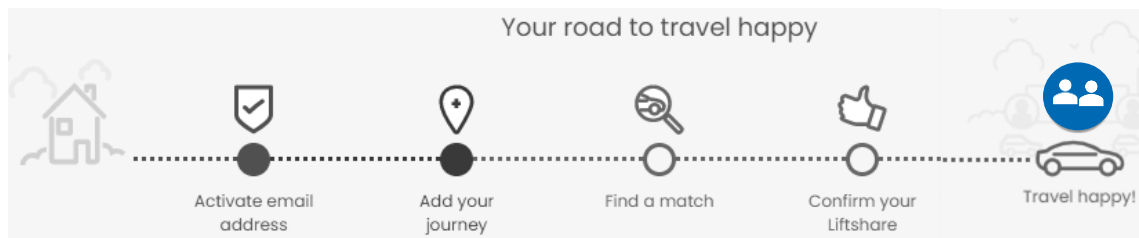
How to join East Cheshire NHS Trust Liftshare Community via

Via a browser (i.e. Google)

1. Go to EastCheshireNHSTrust.liftshare.com (no www. required)
2. Join using @nhs.net email address
3. Verify account via the activation email
4. Sign back into your account
5. Download the free 'Liftshare App'

Via the free Liftshare App

1. Download the free Liftshare App
2. Select 'Join Liftshare'
3. Select 'Join a community'
4. Type and Find: **'East Cheshire NHS'**
5. Join using @nhs.net email address
6. Verify your account via the activation email



Liftshare Trip Authentication

Once you have created a Liftshare account you can post your journey details and find a match to Liftshare with. Once you have found a suitable Liftshare partner you can 'ask to share'. A Liftshare Team will be created once a request to share has been accepted.

At the pickup point of your journey select the 'Authenticate' button and select if you are a driver or a passenger. Scan the QR code on your Liftshare partner's screen. This will authenticate your journey allow you access to the priority Liftshare parking at the Paddock.

Frequently Asked Questions

Why has the Trust signed up for this scheme?

The Trust recognises that parking is a problem at East Cheshire and wanted to partnership with a scheme that delivered on Space saving, Savings for staff and contributes to the Trust sustainability plan.

How do I save Money?

By sharing the journey you not only save on the cost of fuel but will only pay a share of the car parking fees. So for example if 4 people share a car the 1 parking tariff is split across all 4 members of the car share group.

What happens if my Car share driver needs to leave work urgently? How do I get home?

In circumstances that are out of your control the Trust will guarantee a ride home. This maybe with another car sharer or by taxi. Please see separate SOP

What happens if I only share with one person and they are on holiday, or off sick?

If you are signed upto the scheme and cannot trip authenticate because your car share partner is on holiday or off sick then we will provide you with an exemption for this time period. You will still receive priority on-site parking. You will need to e mail the Parking team to advise them when this happens.
